**For Example**

*Art 1301 = Art 1 (9th grade)  
If the student takes Art 1301 in the 9th grade during the school day, the student will also get credit for Art 1, the equivalent high school course.*

Grades earned will be included on high school transcript, class ranking and college GPA.

Students have the opportunity to earn 33 credit hours and possibly 18 hours during summer sessions with **LC Summer College Academy**.\*

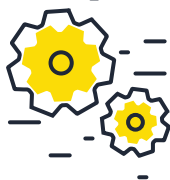
